HOURS OF CARE APPLICATION

For the benefit and safety of the children in our care, no child shall be at Creative Explorations for more than 9.5 hours per day unless enrolled for extended care. This policy is based on child/teacher ratios as mandated by licensing and quality care guidelines set forth by the National Association for the Education of Young Children. All families must choose a consistent schedule of 7 AM-4:30 PM, 7:30 AM-5 PM or 8 AM-5:30 PM. This schedule must be approved by the director. Please note, out infant program is only open from 7:30 AM-5 PM.

Late pick-up negatively impacts the children and staff and will be heavily fined. If you realize you are unable to complete your pick up by the end of your time slot, please contact the staff as soon as possible to alert us. A late fee of \$25 will be collected shall the child be picked up past the scheduled pick up time. If the child is at Creative Explorations more than 15 minutes past scheduled pick up time, a \$5 per minute is applied from then until the child is picked up.
